Baby Think it Over (BTIO)

8th grade Health and Wellness Program where students have an overnight experience with an electronic "newborn". Only a few volunteers needed at a time. Help check out and check in the babies. This is a great opportunity to talk to the students about their experience.

African American Awareness Program (AAAP)

An organization promoting success among students. Celebrates cultural diversity through learning experiences with area leaders, field trips and book readings. Seeking volunteers to mentor the AAAP members on mapping their way to success. Work one on one or facilitate small group learning experiences. Commitment is as much or as little as you can give. Need: Weekly or monthly volunteers to help students organize activities.
